Intent

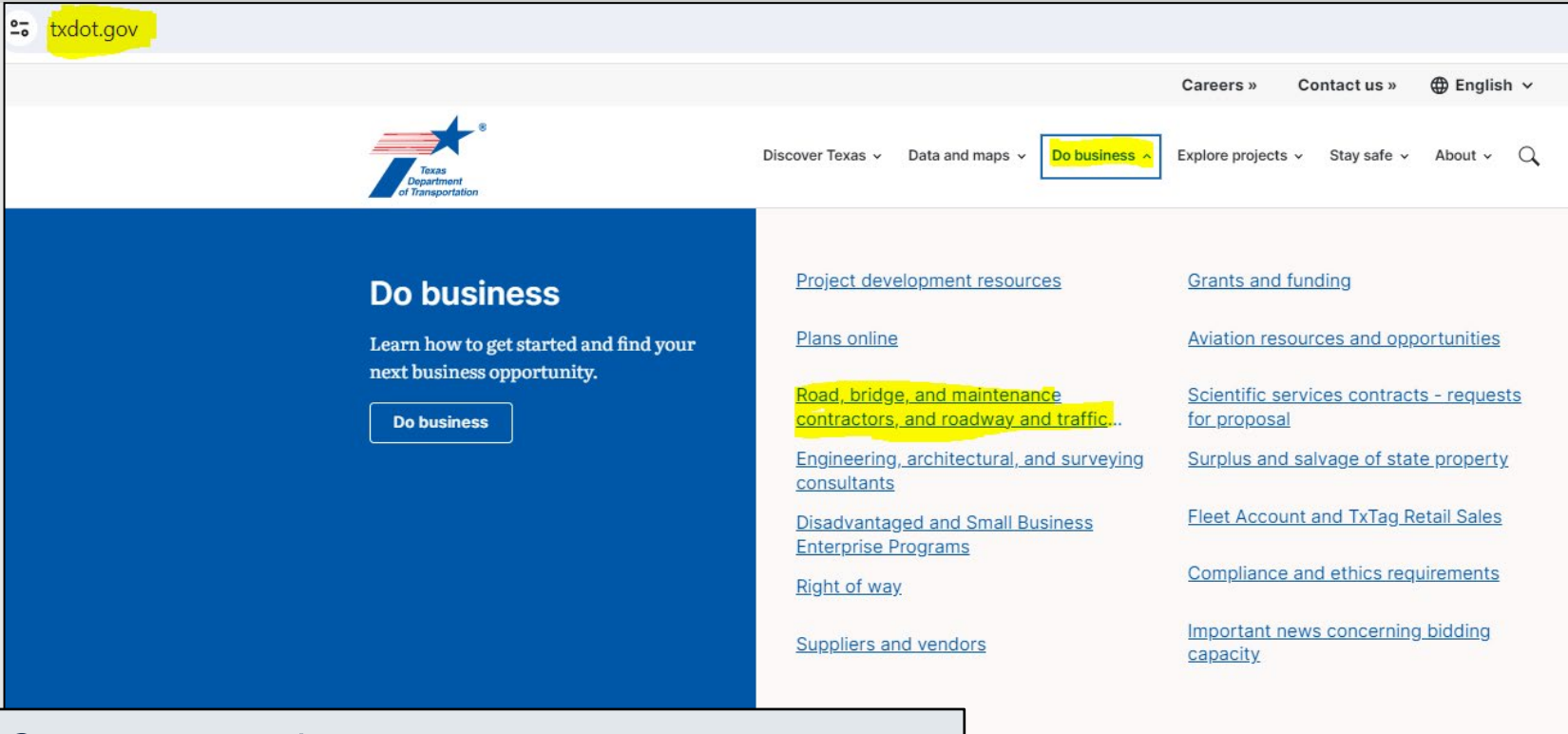
- Provide prospective bidders access to project-specific railroad documents
- Resource to submit informed bids



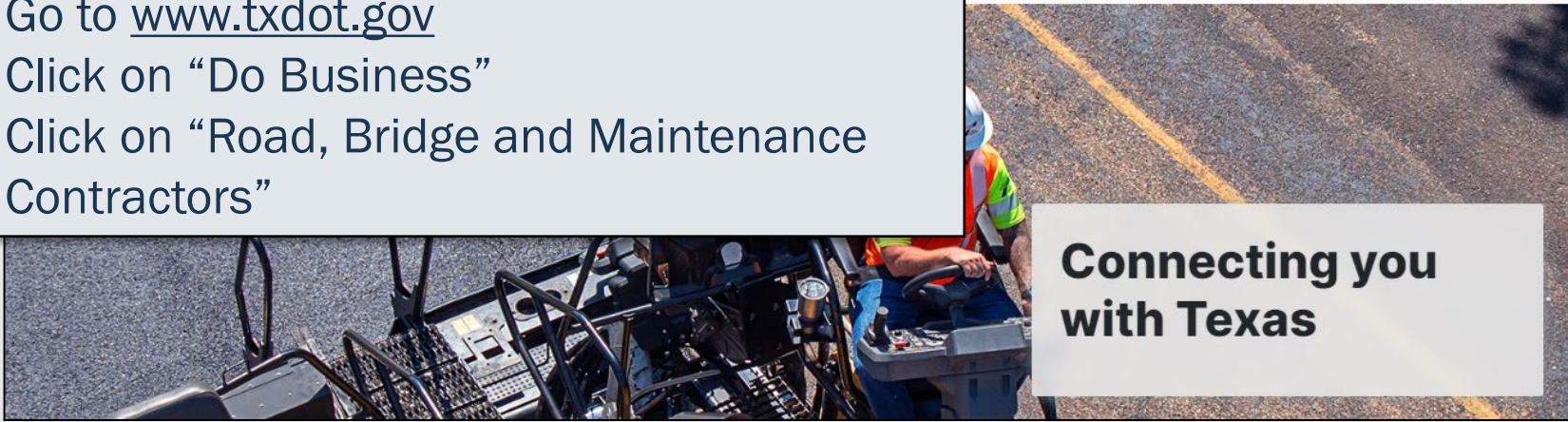
Documents include, but are not limited to:
