The district primarily conducts asset preservation and mobility projects to ensure the safety of the traveling public. **The Fort Worth District oversees \$3.7 billion in construction.**

### KEY PROJECTS UNDERWAY:

- Southeast Connector—rebuild and widen—\$2.1 billion
- I-820/SH 183 from I-35W to SH 121 split—add mainlanes and TEXpress Lanes—\$450 million
- I-30/SH 360 Interchange—\$277 million
- I-820 East Loop—widen—\$174 million
- SH 199 in Lake Worth—add mainlanes—\$104 million
- SH 170—add mainlanes—\$99 million
- US 377 Cresson Relief Route—\$61 million

**MAINTENANCE:** We spend approximately \$153 million annually for preventive, routine and rehabilitative maintenance.

**SAFETY:** Our current and upcoming safety projects include 49 miles of added shoulders along rural roadways in the Erath, Johnson, Palo Pinto and Wise counties for approximately \$70 million.
